OVERVIEW

In 2014, both the City of Los Alamitos and the Los Alamitos School District looked to upgrade their fields, which are subjected to extensive use by students and community sports groups. EcoFert was presented with the task of enhancing sustainable turf on fields that were aggressively used by cleased athletes, such as soccer, football, softball, baseball and lacrosse.

The decision to replace irrigation systems and renovate turf presented an excellent opportunity to utilize the ability of EcoFert's Soil Fertility Program to promote root development and maintain healthy fields. Besides applying a special developed protocol of highly beneficial organic based amendments, EcoFert consulted on beneficial landscape care practices. The results have been dramatic.
